### 1. MINUTE OF PREVIOUS MEETING

- Mother and Toddler Group may have to fold due to the opening of more Nursery Classes at Milne's Primary School. They are to continue in the hall meantime
- The terms and Conditions have now been updated
- A brochure showing the facilities available in the Stage area has been produced
- The Islander Play was very well advertised. Takings were divided 80% to Production Team and 20% to Hall.
- Air conditioning information has still to come from G&A Construction
- Data Protection information is now displayed in Hall and Stewart Harris to add to website.

# 2. FILM CLUB

A committee has been formed and the first film will be shown on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> September 2018 will be Sunshine in Leith.

# 3. ACCOUNTS

- Electricity payment was high due to that SSE not charging for fuel since 2017. The accounts are now up to date.
- The stage lights are not to be switched on until needed as they are heavy on electric
- Awards for all award of £10000 and EB award of £15000 will be used to cover the cost of the chairs - £3400, tables - £2843, G&A Construction £1600 and Carpet for Balcony - £2400
- Covering for stage is to be looked at.
- There is to be a review of hall charges. This has been deferred to the next meeting to allow comparisons with other hall charges. All day hire is also to be reviewed to include bar charges if required.
- An advert has been placed in the Knock News for next four issues at a cost of £300

## 6. A.O.C.B

- Initial enquiries for a Public Entertainment Licence was quoted at £270 per event, however after further investigation, a licence was purchased for £232 to cover a 3-year period.
- Sam is to undertake a Personal Licence Course
- Blinds have been ordered by Men's Sheds for the upstairs windows facing the car park
- Sam asked for clarification of who should submit booking forms for Village Association events. It was agreed that this should be lain Rennie or Sybil Stuart
- It was agreed that one-off bookings, eg wedding, concerts etc should not go on the calendar until a deposit has been received, but that a diary should be maintained to avoid double booking.
